Peach JAMboree Scholarship Information

The Stonewall Chamber of Commerce will select one to three graduating seniors to receive scholarships for furthering their education beyond high school. Scholarship amounts will be decided and allocated by the Stonewall Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors based upon the funds available. A Scholarship Committee will be selected by the Stonewall Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors to review applications, conduct interviews if needed, and recommend finalists to the Directors. The Stonewall Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors will approve the final selections.

Application

Application will consist of a resume, 4 essay questions and a reference page. Application instructions may be requested through your school counseling center or by visiting the Stonewall Chamber of Commerce website, www.stonewalltexas.com. Applications MUST be typed. Completed applications must be submitted via email to stonewallchamber@gmail.com with a subject line of "2019 Scholarship Application".

Deadline

All applications must be received via email by Friday, April 5th, 2019.

Interview

By submitting an application, the applicant agrees to be available for an interview if required by the Scholarship Committee and gives permission to the Committee to contact the references provided on the application.

Notification

The recipient(s) of the scholarship(s) will be notified during their school scholarship ceremony or via mail. Recipient(s) should be available for public recognition of the award on Saturday of the Peach JAMboree, June 22nd, 2019.

Create a resume with the following information:

- Name
- Address
- Phone number
- School
- Graduation date
- Current GPA
- Extracurricular activities
- Volunteer experience
- Work experience

On a separate page(s) WITHOUT identifying information (name, etc) please answer the following questions:

1. How have you been involved in/provided service to the Stonewall Community?
2. Please list the three extracurricular activities most important to you during your high school years. Describe how these activities helped you become a better person and student.
3. How do you intend to further your education after high school? Have you been accepted to a college, university or trade school?
4. How do you intend to pay for furthering your education? Do you have financial need for a scholarship? Please list all other scholarships that you have been awarded and the amount of each.

Include a reference page listing three references (at least one teacher and at least one personal reference). Include a phone number where they can be reached and their relationship to you.
